The International Software Testing Qualifications Board (ISTQB) was founded in Edinburgh in November 2002.

The ISTQB is responsible for the international qualification scheme called "ISTQB Certified Tester". The qualifications are based on syllabi. At the moment the qualification consists of two levels: Foundation Level and Advanced Level.

The contents of each syllabus are taught as courses by training providers, which have to be accredited by national boards.

Each course is concluded by an examination covering the contents of the syllabus. After the examination, each successful participant receives an official ISTQB certificate.
